### **Software portal for cellphones on show**

Among the booths at the exhibition hall during WCIT 2008 was a display by the FSBM Multimedia and Communications Group, a software company pushing a soft of software portal for mobile phones.

The product, called UNOS Pro, is an extended version FSBM's UNOS Voice, a Voice-over-Internet Protocol (VoIP) type of application that is similar to Skype's Skype Out service (see *In.Tech*, May 8).

UNOS Pro has a completely redesigned interface and adds a number of new services to the mix, namely a new S-MailS service which allows you to receive push e-mail on your mobile phone or simultaneously send SMS and e-mail messages.

A new free service has also been added under S-MailS – MY Government – which allows you to check, amongst other things, when your driving licence expires or whether you have any outstanding traffic summonses.

Along with these new features, this Java-based software has also been upgraded with a more graphical icon-based user-interface.

Of course, the UNOS Voice application still exists within UNOS Pro and is largely unchanged – the software allows you to buy credit online to make cheaper phone calls, conference calls and even calls from a hotel phone at lower rates than if not using the service.

UNOS Pro is available for free and works on any phone supporting Java (J2ME) and any telco service with an EDGE, GPRS or 3G connction – it can be downloaded by pointing your phone's browser to **get.myunos.com** and downloading the client.

Users are provided with a complimentary USD1 (RM 3.30) worth of credit.
